

**General Requirements for the
2011 Elderly & Totally Disabled Homeowners Program**

Homeowners, 65 years and older, who meet specific guidelines, may be eligible for property tax relief. Below are the general requirements for the program. Please contact the Assessment Office at 860-561-7414 with any questions you may have.

— This is a State Program —

Age Requirement:	65 years of age as of December 31, 2011
Application Period:	February 1 - May 15, 2012
Maximum Income Allowed:	Single: \$32,300 Married: \$39,500
Information Needed:	Date of Birth and Social Security Numbers for Applicants; Proof of ALL income for 2011 (taxable or not taxable)
Benefit:	Works on a sliding scale: Minimum of \$150 off taxes Maximum of \$1250 off taxes

Elderly & Totally Disabled Homeowner Program Checklist

The state requires proof of all income. Please submit the following when applying for the Elderly Homeowner Program:

- A copy of the 1099 form from Social Security;
- A copy of a **COMPLETE** Income Tax Return for 2011 **including ALL schedules**;
- If no Income Tax Return was filed, submit copies of **ALL** 1099 forms;
- Copies of receipts for Rental Income, if applicable;
- W-2 forms, if applicable

(The list above is not all inclusive and is not intended to be so. Failure to provide complete proof of income can result in forfeiture of this benefit.)
